Why do you come to school?

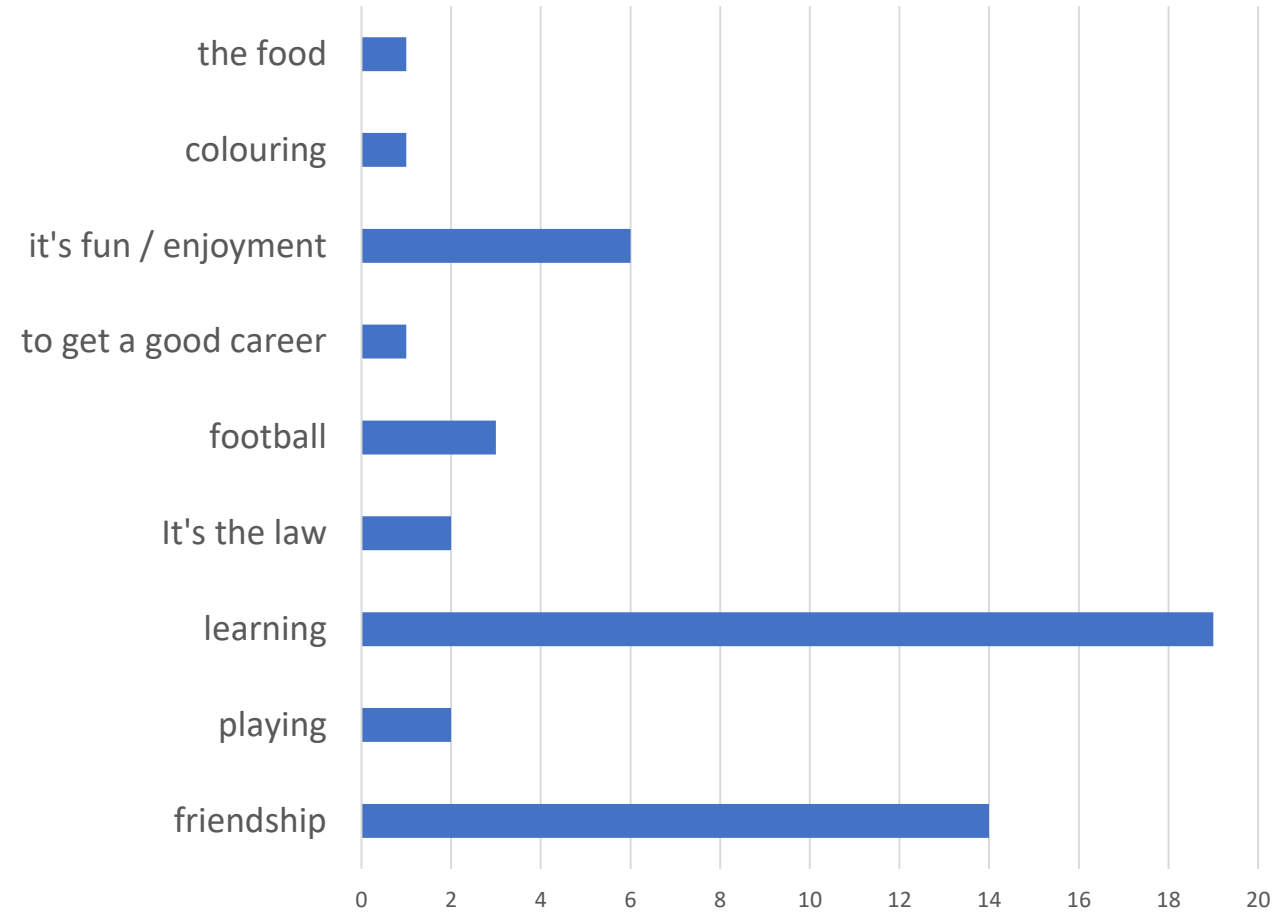
We asked you to name your top three reasons for coming to school each day.

Why do some people not come to school each day?

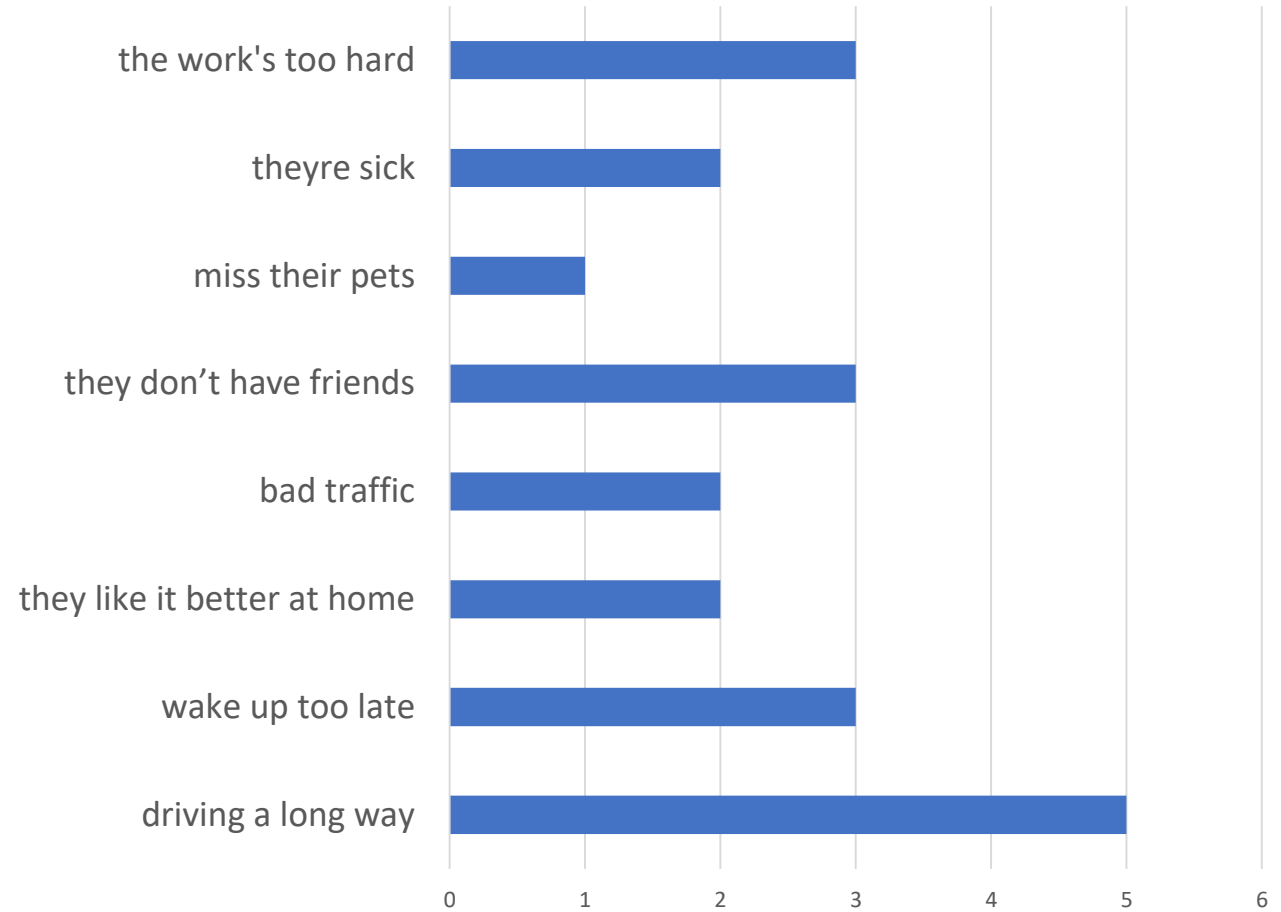
We asked you what you thought might make it hard for children to come to school each school day.

We asked you how children may feel if they were absent from school.

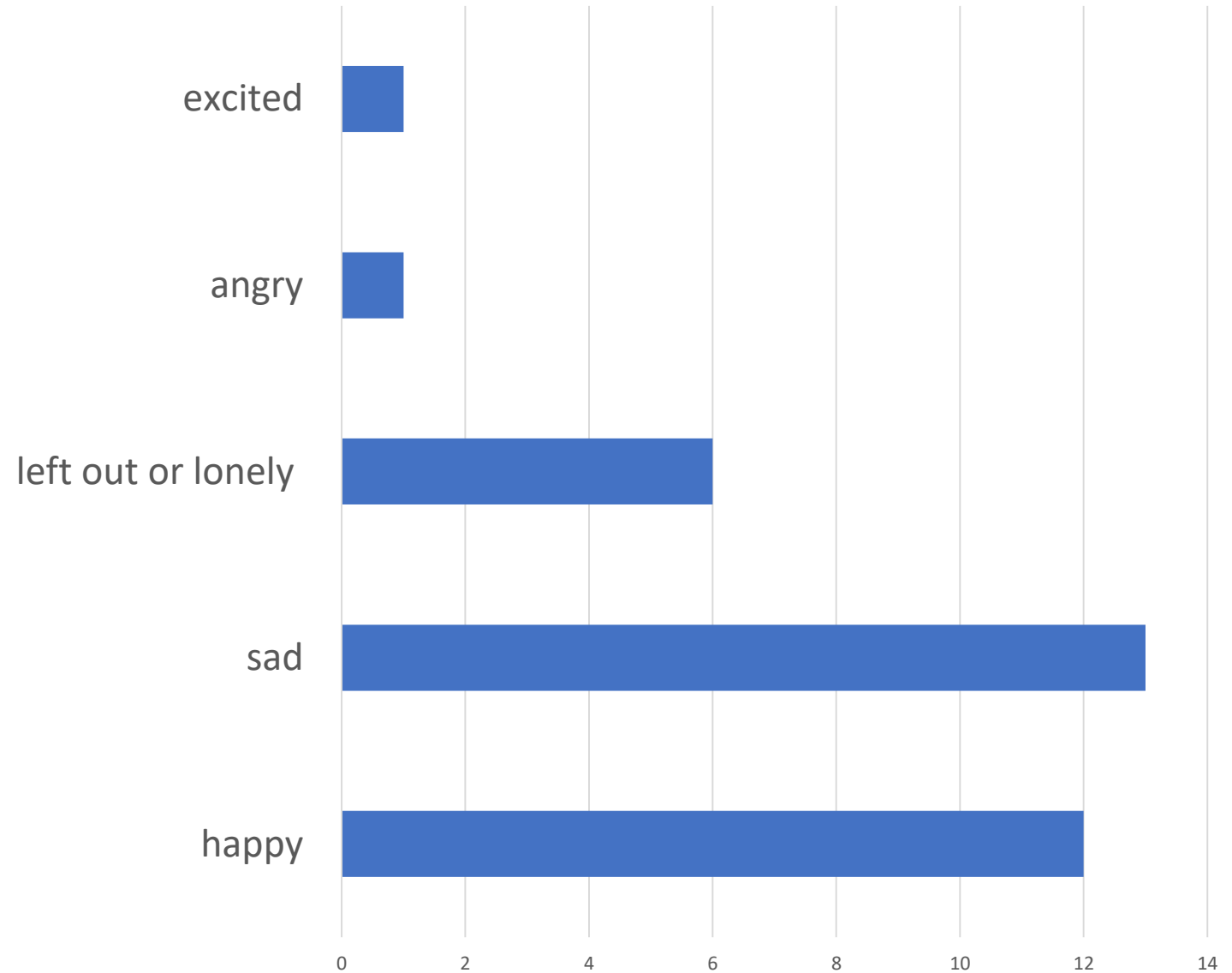

How might people feel when they come back to school?

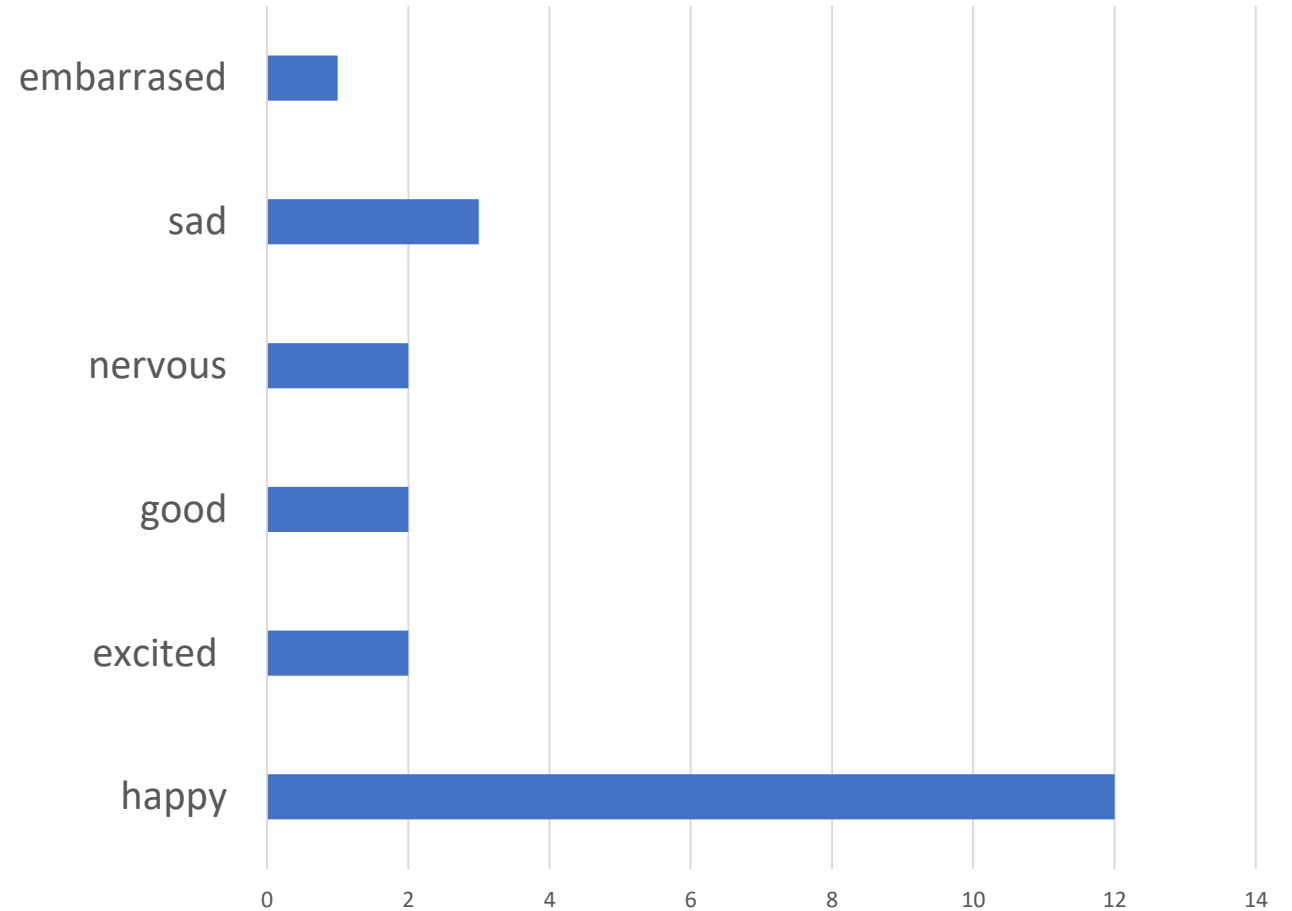
We asked you how children may feel when they come back to school after being absent for a while.

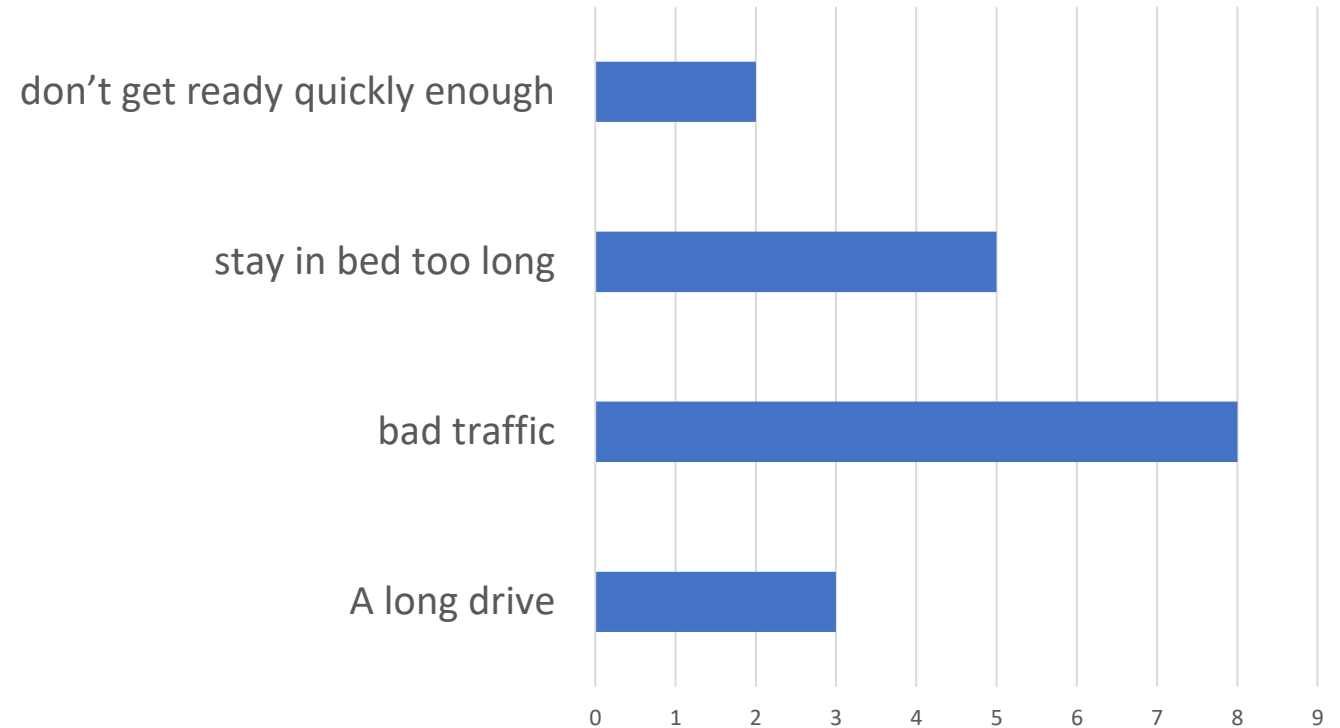
What about being late for school?

Why?



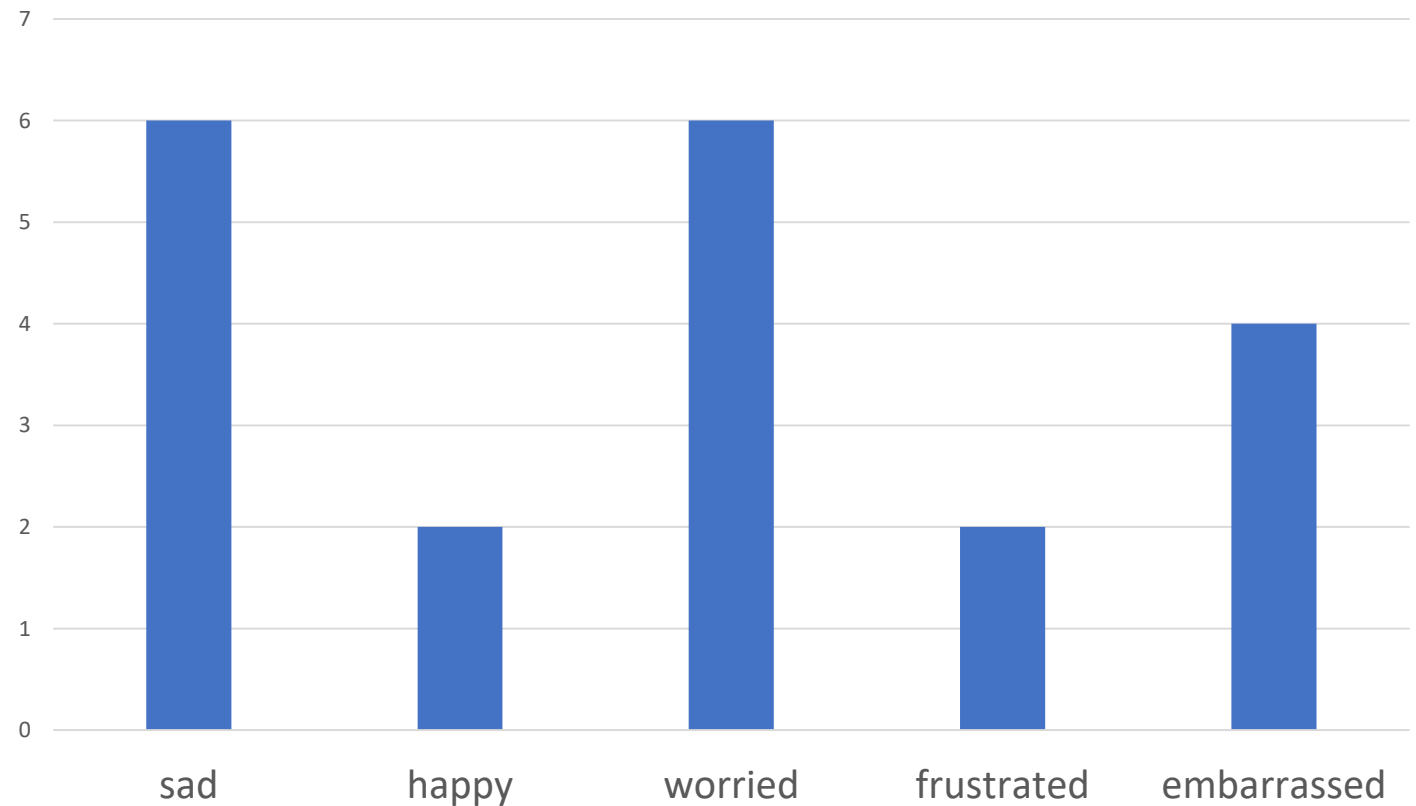
How do we feel about being late for school?
