English

Outcome: Children will learn to write in the following genres:

Mathematics

Outcome: National Curriculum requirements following the mastery approach :

Year 1

Numbers to 10, Part-whole within 10, Addition within 10, Subtraction within 10, 2D and 3D shapes

Year 2

Numbers to 100, Addition and subtraction (1), Addition and subtraction (2), Properties of shape

Science

Outcome 1: Children will learn about animals including humans. They will think about what they looked like as a baby and how they've changed.

Outcome 2: Children will learn about seasonal changes and the four seasons. They will learn about the sun and shadows.

RE

Outcome 1: Children will explore the festival of Shabbat

Outcome 2: Children will learn about harvest and Christmas celebrations.

Lifeskills (PSHE)

Outcome 1: Children will learn about what keeping healthy means.

Outcome 2: Children will learn about the parts of the body including external genitalia.

Outcome 3: Children will learn about different strengths and what is needed to do a particular job or skill.

PE

Outcome: Dance

NS Sports programme: Gymnastics, Netball, Basketball, Dodgeball

History

Outcome: Children will learn about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements focusing on Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.

Computing

Outcome 1: Children will learn about online safety.

Outcome 2: Children will learn about spreadsheets and how to use them.

Geography

Outcome 1: Children will use compass directions, locational and directional language to describe the location of features on a map looking at aerial photographs and plan perspectives.

Outcome 2: Children will devise a map and use and construct basic symbols in a key.

Outcome 3: Children will use simple fieldwork to study the geography of the Memorial Park.

Art

Outcome 1: Children will explore and draw and be introduced to the idea that artists can be collectors and explorers as they develop skills.

Outcome 2: Children will explore simple ways to make a print and will explore pattern, sequencing and symmetry.

Design Technology

Outcome: Children will design and make a fruit salad.

Music

Outcome: The children will perform simple rhythmic accompaniments to music on untuned percussion instruments demonstrating an awareness of pulse and rhythm. They will explore movement to music investigating Gumboot dancing and North Indian Kathak Dance.
