

Zooming In! (Connecting Concept – Identity)

English

Outcome: Children will learn to write in the following genres:

Writing to Entertain

- Retellings Character/in role Descriptions

Writing to Inform

- Non Chronological reports reports about Space
- Instruction writing How to make a moon Buggy

To support this writing the following punctuation and Grammar will be taught - Y2 conjunctions, contractions, homophones, proper nouns, verbs, adverbs, sentences, pronouns, commas and suffixes. Y1 conjunctions, plural, proper nouns, verbs, adverbs, sentences and adjectives.

Mathematics

Outcome: National Curriculum requirements following the mastery approach :

Year 1 - Numbers to 20, Addition and subtraction within 20, Numbers to 50, Introducing length and height, Introducing mass and capacity

Year 2 - Money, Multiplication and Division (1), Multiplication and division (2), Length and height, Mass, capacity and temperature

Science

Outcome 1: Children will learn about everyday materials and their properties, focussing particularly on absorbency and waterproofing of materials.

Outcome 2: Children will learn about materials and explore changes. eg melting/heating.

RE

Outcome 1: Children will explore the ideas of whether it is important to celebrate New Year.

Outcome 2: Children will learn stories from the old testament and explore their importance and the ideas raised.

Lifeskills (PSHE)

Outcome 1: Children will learn about a range of feelings that humans can experience.

Outcome 2: Children will explore different strategies to cope with a range of feelings, including those surrounding loss.

PE

Outcome: Gymnastic skills

NS Sports programme: Gymnastics, Netball, Basketball, Dodgeball

History

Outcome1 : Children will look at the lives of Ernest Shackleton and Robert Falcon Scott. They will make a timeline of events and explain why they are famous.

Outcome 2: Children will compare the similarities and differences between the two explorers.

Computing

Outcome 1: Children will learn about pictograms and use them to record results.

Outcome 2: Children will learn about questioning and to construct a binary tree.

Outcome 3: Children will study a range of artists and use the 2paint a picture tool.

Geography

Outcome 1: Children will learn about the place of Earth in the solar system.

Outcome 2: Children will name and locate the world's 7 continents and oceans and locate them on maps.

Outcome 3: Children will compare similarities and differences looking at human and physical features of Kenya and the UK.,

Outcome 4: Children will identify seasonal weather patterns and describe the location in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

Art

Outcome 1: Children will explore materials and intentions through a playful approach.

Outcome 2: Children will explore how we can make art inspired by the sounds we hear.

Design Technology

Outcome: Children will design and create a moon buggy with working axles and wheels.

Music

Outcome: The children will explore how sound can be produced in different ways on instruments and voice. They will investigate how composers use dynamics, tempo and timbre to reflect a character or theme and compose their own sound sequences to tell a story.
