Outcome: Children will learn to write in the following genres:

Mathematics

Outcome: National Curriculum requirements following the mastery approach :

Outcome 3: The children will imagine a day at the seaside today taking part in role play and producing descriptive writing.

Computing

Outcome 1: Children will learn about spreadsheets in 2 calculate.
Outcome 2: Children will learn about effective searching tools on the internet.
Outcome 3: Children will learn about presenting ideas in different ways.

Geography

Outcome 1: Children will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding area.
Outcome 2: The children will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key physical and human features of the seaside.

Art

Outcome 1: Children will explore how painters can use paint in an expressive and gestural way with colour mixing to create abstract still life.
Outcome 2: Children will explore how you can transform a familiar object into new and fun forms using sticks.

Design Technology

Outcome: Children use sliders and levers to create a moving picture of a pirate ship on the sea.

Music

Outcome: **High or Low** The children will identify and describe sounds made by instruments and voice. They will be able to copy pitch patterns, compose simple sound effects to enhance a performance and start using graphic notation scores.
