


# Suspended Spider



## You will need:

Black paint

A3 black and orange paper

Black string


White chalk

Scissors

Glue

Paintbrushes

Newspaper



## Instructions:

1. Spread newspaper over the work area.
2. Paint the inside of the palm and fingers (not the thumb!) with black paint.
3. With fingers slightly spread, press palm on orange paper so that the fingers are pointing to the right side of the paper. Make an identical print with fingers pointing to the left side of the paper, overlapping the palm prints completely (see illustration).
4. Glue a piece of black string to the paper, extending from the top of the spider's body to the top of the page.
5. Cut a circle out of black paper and glue it above the handprints for the spider's head. Once dry, draw a face with white chalk.

You may like to make a large web by attaching black string to the wall and then taping the children's spider prints to the web.
