

Ancient Egypt (Connecting Concept – Resourcefulness)

English

Outcome: The children will learn to:

Write to inform- News reports

Write to entertain. - Character description

To support this writing the following punctuation and grammar will be learnt:

Prepositions, paragraphs, headings, direct and indirect speech, expanded noun phrase, adverbial phrase, future tense. Comprehension skills will support and compliment this.

Mathematics

Year 3 – Multiplication and division, expanded written methods, problem solving, length and perimeter, fractions as number and object, mass, capacity, multiplication and division facts 2x,3x,4x,5x,8x,10x.

Year 4 - Multiplication and division, informal written methods, correspondence problems, problem solving, length and perimeter, fractions as mixed numbers and improper, add and subtract fractions, decimals, multiplication and division facts 2x,3x,4x,5x,8x,10x.

Science

Outcome: Through experimentation and observation the children will have an understanding of what forces and magnets are, how they work and their uses in every day life.

The children will investigate the different parts of a plant, the conditions for growth and factors which can effect their health and success.

RE

Outcome 1: The children will explore different reasons for making a Holy journey and places traditionally visited as Pilgrimages.

Outcome 2: Children will explore the ritual of communion.

Lifeskills (PSHE)

Outcome 1: The children will explore personal relationships including friendships and personal boundaries.

Outcome 2: The children will understand the concept of peer pressure and know where to get help and support.

PE

Outcome 1: Children will learn the skills necessary for invasion games including, speed, direction, attack and defense.

Outcome 2: Dance – The children will develop their creativity of movement in response to musical stimuli.

History/Geography

Outcome:

The children will use a range of evidence sources to have an overall understanding of the Ancient Egyptians, their locality, ways of life and their impact on life today.

Computing

Outcome 1: Children will develop their touch typing, learning the correct posture, keyboard positioning and use.

Outcome 2: Using spreadsheets, children will collect data and present it using a range of graphs.

MFL French

Outcome: Children will be able to recognise, read and write classroom commands and colours. They will also know numbers 0 – 10 and learn that French words have a gender.

Art

Outcome 1: **Gestural Drawing** They will have made loose, gestural drawings with charcoal, exploring drama.

Outcome 2: **Working with Shape and Colour** They will have painted with Scissors. Collage and stencil in response to looking at artwork.

Design Technology

Outcome: The children will understand how to construct shell structures through, discussion, research, design and collaboration.

Music

Outcome: The children will learn about musical contrasts, exploring the instrumental timbres, changing in tones from minor to major and using the inter related dimensions of music to create interest and effect. They will experience music from the Baroque era and pop culture.
