Science

Outcome 1: Having explored the different parts of a plant the children will investigate their life cycle and how water is transported within the plant.

Outcome 2: The children investigate light sources, reflection and shadows and how to use it safely.

Outcome 2: To understand the features of Lent and the link to the temptation of Jesus in the desert.

Outcome 1: Athletics, throwing, jumping, running techniques.

Outcome: The children will use a combination of maps, atlases and digital mapping with fieldwork to explore our local area.

Computing

Outcome 1: The children will identify the risks and benefits of a digital footprint and learn how to protect themselves from online identity theft.

Outcome 2: The children will explore how font size, colour and style can affect the impact of the text.

Outcome: The children will be able to speak, read and put into sentences numbers 1- 12, animals and colours.

Art

Outcome 1: Using natural Materials to Make Images. The children will have used natural pigments and dyes from the environment to make art.

Outcome 2: Exploring Still Life The children will have researched artists working with the still life genre and create their own inspired art work.

Design Technology

Outcome: The children will research, investigate and design a pneumatic system to create moving parts.

Music

Outcome: The children will learn about melodies and song structures. They will develop improvisation skills, compose melodies using a small note range and explore the structure of songs and music, including music from the Classical era and folk dance from Israel, Japan and Scotland.
