Science

Outcome 1: Athletics, throwing, jumping, running techniques.

History/Geography

Outcome: Use arrange of maps, atlases and texts to contrast the UK with a European location. The children will compare physical and human features, climate and global position.

Computing

Outcome 1: The children will learn to sort objects using a branching data base.

Outcome 2: The children will explore how to make a presentation using powerpoint.

MFL French

Outcome: The children will learn to speak, read and write numbers 7- 12, masculine animals and the verb to have.

They will be able to ask simple questions and construct a phrase or sentence using the French vocabulary.

Art

Outcome1: **Animated Drawings**The children will explore how to create moving drawings by making paper puppets and animate them.

Outcome 2: **Festival Feasts** The children will explore how food and art can bring us together.

Design Technology

Outcome: The children will use an electrical system to light up a shell structure incorporating switches, cells and bulbs.
