### English

### Mathematics

Yr3 – Place value within 1,000, addition and subtraction, complements to 100, estimate, inverse operation, problem solving, multiplication and division, 2x,3x,4x,5x,8x,10x  
Yr4 – Place value, 4 digit numbers, rounding to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, addition and subtraction column method, area, multiplication and division, 3x,6x,9x,7x,11x, 12x,1x, 0x.

### Science

Outcome 1: Using investigations, experiments and fair testing, the children will explore sound, how its made, travels and factors affecting volume.  
Outcome2: The children will learn about the human digestive system, our teeth and their functions. They will also explore food chains.

### RE

Outcome 1: The children will read and explore the miracles in the bible and discuss how they may influence people today.  
Outcome 2: The children will understand the role of Mary in the Christmas story.

### Lifeskills (PSHE)

Outcome 1: To explore and understand age restrictions and how they promote personal safety and well being.  
Outcome 2: To understand different attitudes towards saving and spending and how decisions are made.

Outcome 1: The children will use a range of evidence sources to understand more about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain, who they were, where they came from and how they lived every day life.

Outcome 2. The children will understand a flow chart and simple commands including repeat and if within coding.
