## Introduction

This document describes the school's policy regarding its uniform. The school believes that wearing a smart, practical uniform helps pupils to feel a sense of pride and belonging. Every child is expected to wear the uniform as described in this document. Only in exceptional circumstances that are agreed in advance with the head teacher will this rule be waived.

The school uniform varies between summer and winter. The winter uniform is worn during the autumn and spring terms. Pupils may wear the summer uniform in the autumn term up until the beginning of October if they wish.

Neither jewellery nor makeup is permitted. If a pupil has pierced ears, then that pupil may wear no more than one small, plain stud in each ear. These must be removed or taped over during PE lessons. All items of uniform must be clearly named.

## Purchasing the uniform

The school is careful to ensure that the uniform is easy to find in numerous high-street stores in order to keep the cost down. The school jumpers, cardigans, T-shirts, PE shorts, fleeces and ties are available to purchase from the school. Second-hand uniform sales are held from time-to-time to give parents the opportunity to buy good quality uniforms at low prices.
